Owners Annabelle and Simon invited me to stay the weekend, and it ended up being such a peaceful and welcoming visit. And I actually had the best nap I've had in years there.

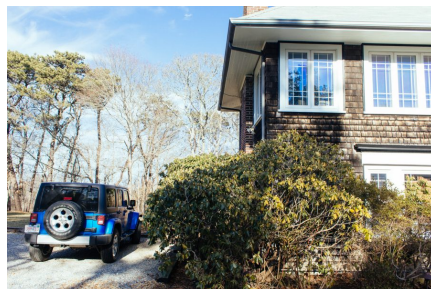

Once I arrived, I had a quick tour of the common areas and the guest rooms.

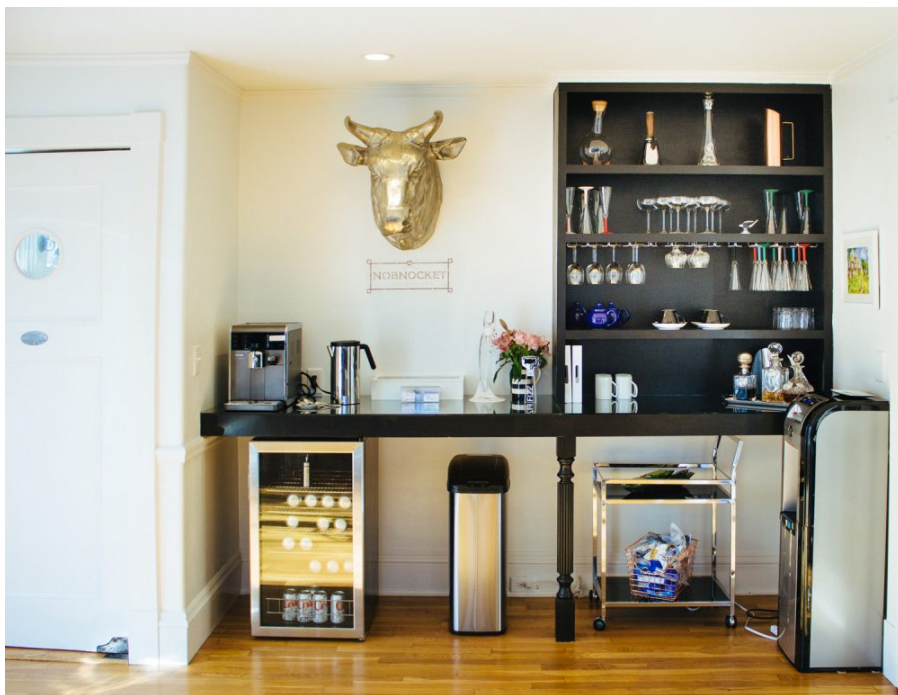
The common areas are perfect for morning coffee, happy hours or night caps. Couches galore and a lovely complimentary bar.





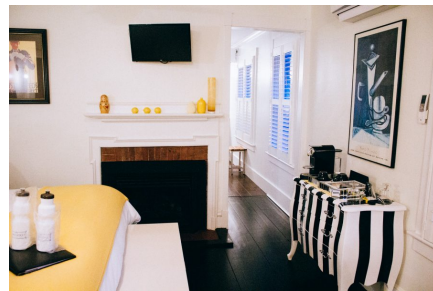
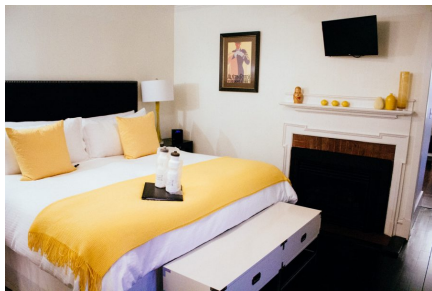
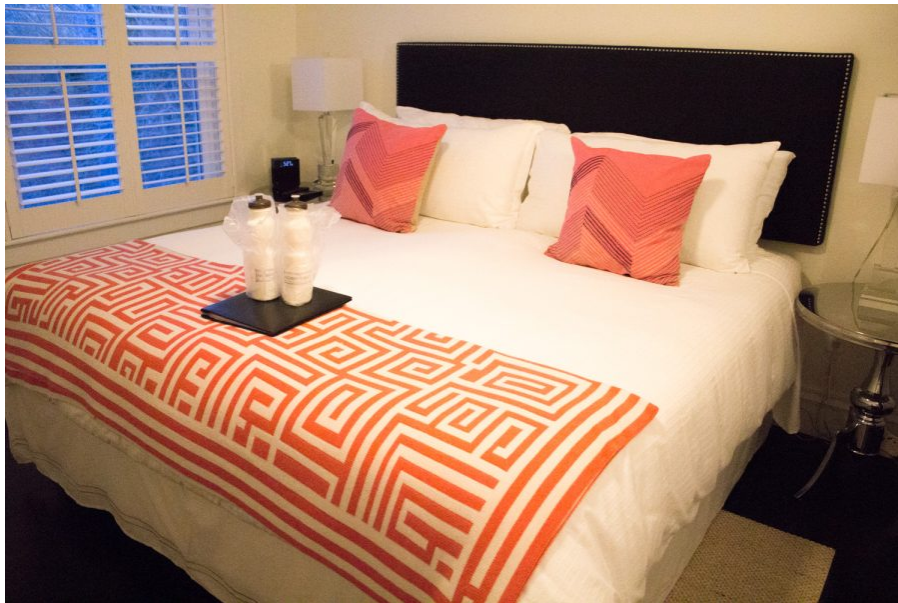


I especially love the breakfast/bar area. All of your needs are covered – water, coffee, tea, hard stuff. Anything you might need!

In the morning, the Nobnocket team offers a complimentary breakfast either served in the common area or in your room. Most rooms have a table and chairs just for this reason.

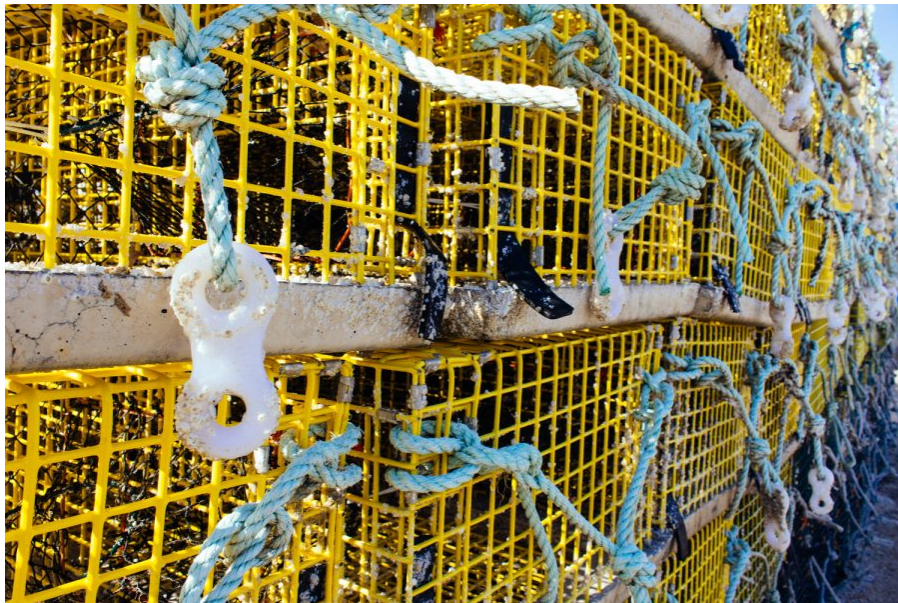
While we're talking about food and if you're in need of a dinner rec while you're on the island, go to [State Road](#). It is OUTSTANDING.
