This historic hotel was built in 1908 and sits on approximately two acres of land, including large lawn areas and woodland. Despite the historic nature of the hotel, the large rooms are decorated in a contemporary style. Communal areas of the hotel include a sitting room with a fireplace, a veranda, a sunroom, a patio and a dining room. The hotel is located on the edge of the coastal village Vineyard Haven and is less than 15 minutes from the ferry.
