SEPTEMBER

Living Local Harvest Fest - West Tisbury
 Get up close and personal with island nonprofits, local farms, food folks, and community organizations as you tour more than 50 booths chock full of education and fun stuff to do.

OCTOBER

Martha's Vineyard Food & Wine Festival - Edgartown
 This festival celebrates more than just the culinary prowess of the island's favorite chefs, but the farmers and fishermen supplying the preeminent ingredients.

NOVEMBER

Vineyard Artisans - Edgartown
 Thanksgiving Weekend Festival - West Tisbury
 Expect scores of hand-made sweaters and soaps and fine crafts including leather and vintage bags, wood butcher block cutting boards, and more.

Martha's Vineyard International Film Festival - Edgartown
 For six days, the Martha's Vineyard Film Society shows a unique collection of the best feature and short films from top-notch festivals, like Sundance, Berlin, and Cannes.

Grand Tasting Winemaker's Tables - Edgartown
 Thirty-five celebrated chefs, 300 curated libations, and purveyors from local farms, fisheries, and shellfish growers come to the Winnetu Oceanside Resort for demos, tastings, and book signings.

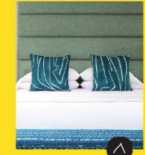
Black Sheep - Edgartown

The Martha's Vineyard Museum - Vineyard Haven

Top Hotels

THE WINNETU OCEANSIDE RESORT - Mattakesett

THE SYDNEY - Edgartown
